John Strong (b.ca.1675) moved from Hanover County to New Kent County, Virginia during or before 1698.

Descendants lived in Virginia, North Carolina, Georgia, Mississippi, Tennessee, Kentucky and elsewhere.

Includes records of some early Strong residents of Virginia, without establishing lineage to John.

Contains regulations for mourning doves, white-winged doves, band-tailed pigeons, rails, woodcock, snipe, sea ducks, teal in Sept., ducks in 4 states, sandhill cranes, gallinules, and all migratory game birds in Alaska, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and Hawaii.
